'Strategic Risk and Crisis Management in terrorist situations and the key learning from the Manchester Arena Enquiry'

Speaker: Scott Wilson

In February 2019 Scott was appointed as the Subject Matter Expert in relation to the Police Response and Counter Terrorism for the Manchester Public Inquiry working to the chair of the enquiry Sir John Saunders until January 2022. Scott has a Master Degree in Critical Incident Management from Middlesex University and is a Fellow of the Institute of Civil Protection and Emergency Management. He is also a Senior Associate lecturer at the Cabinet Office Emergency Planning College. He is a graduate of the Leadership in Counter Terrorism (LinCT) Course completed at FBI Headquarters in Washington in 2015. In 2016 in San Diego, he was awarded the 9/11 International Police Medal for Counter Terrorism
