Toledo City Tour

Along the route, we will visit some of the most important and iconic places of Toledo which has been declared a **World Heritage City by UNESCO**. The streets and squares of Toledo offer tourists two thousand years of history, enclosed in the charm of this city that was once an Imperial City, and at the same time home to three cultures; Christian, Muslim and Jewish, in coexistence and tolerance.



Perched on a mountain and surrounded by the Tagus River, lies the grandiose Toledo. The legend attributes the foundation of the city to the descendants of the Trojans, Telemón and Bruto.

Toledo had its maximum splendor during the Middle Ages and in fact became the capital of the Spanish Empire in the 16th century under Emperor Charles I, when Spain was the largest and most powerful Kingdom in the world.







- We will leave Toledo and we will be transferred by bus to **D. Quijote Land** (45 minutes approx..)
- DON QUIXOTE LAND (Consuegra)
- **D. Quixote**, is a **picturesque and delirious medieval knight** as well as the main character of the **most universal novel** (of the same name) in the Spanish literature ever, written by one of the greatest Spanish writers, **Miguel de Cervantes**. The novel recounts the adventures, misadventures and wanderings of this singular knight.



One of the most famous scenes of the novel is the one in which Don Quixote mistakes the Windmills for giants and launches into battle against them.

Precisely those windmills are the ones we will visit in the small town of Consuegra, in the region of Castilla - la Mancha, native land and scenery of the stories of the medieval Knight Don Quijote de la Mancha.



Granada is located in the southeast of the Iberian Peninsula and being one of the most important cities in Andalusia, it is also one of the most beautiful cities in the country and whose history is fundamental to understand the history of Spain.



Granada has been settled since ancient times by Iberians, Romans, and Visigoths and Muslims. The current settlement became a major city of Al-Andalus in the 11th century during the Zirid Taifa of Granada. In the 13th century it became the capital of the Emirate of Granada under Nasrid rule, the last Muslim-ruled state in the Iberian Peninsula. Granada was conquered in 1492 by the Catholic Monarchs and progressively transformed into a Christian city over the course of the 16th century.








The Alhambra visit

The Alhambra built in the 13th century is an impressive and fabulous monumental complex, being simultaneously a fortress and a palace with majestic gardens erected by the Muslim monarchs of the Nasrid dynasty of the Kingdom of Granada. It is the symbol of the city, the most visited monument in Spain, and the crowning work of Muslim art in Europe. The Alhambra was declared a World Heritage Site in 1984. Its name comes from the color of its walls (Al-Hamra in Arabic) that were made with the clay of the land itself, hence its reddish color.

The substratum of its inhabitants brings together Iberian, Roman, Jewish, Visigothic, Muslim and Christian people. Today, Barcelona is recognized as a global city for its cultural, financial, commercial and touristic importance. It has one of the most important ports in the Mediterranean and is also an very important communication point between Spain and France. During our panoramic bus tour we will have the opportunity to contemplate the main tourist sites and wonderful monuments of the city such as Monument to Christopher Columbus, La Pedrera, Arc de Triomf, Montjuic Area, etc.

Sagrada Familia – Inside Guided Tour

This majestic monument / basilica, proud symbol of Barcelona, is Mr Gaudí's masterpiece and the greatest exponent of Catalan & Spanish modernist architecture. It is the most visited monument in Spain, and the second most visited church in Europe after St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican. When fully completed (expected 2026), it will be the tallest Christian church in the world.

The show is composed of different artists. who perform flamenco singing, guitar and dance that transmit all the passion and magic of flamenco, one of the richest and most complex traditions declared Intangible Cultural Heritage by UNESCO.

Cádiz is a Spanish city and municipality, located in the south of the Iberian Peninsula, in the extreme southwest of continental Europe, capital of the province of the same name, in the autonomous community of Andalusia. The history of Cádiz is that of a city marked by its strategic military and commercial location, straddling the Atlantic Ocean and the Mediterranean Sea. It is one of the oldest Phoenician settlements in the West. Since its foundation by the Tyrians, according to classical tradition eighty years after the Trojan War (1104 BC), it was a city overturned to the sea and to commerce. The city of Cádiz in its long history has been a very important site for different civilizations that have conquered it, such as Romans, Visigoths, Muslims, French, etc.



Málaga is a Spanish city and municipality, located in the south-east of the Iberian Peninsula, capital of the province of the same name, in the autonomous community of Andalusia. Founded by the Phoenicians in the 8th century BC, it is one of the oldest cities in Europe. It was first a federated municipality, then of Latin law of the Roman Empire and a prosperous Andalusian medina four times capital of its own kingdom, which was incorporated into the Crown of Castile in 1487. During the 19th century it experienced a remarkable industrial and revolutionary activity that placed it as the first industrial city in Spain and made it worthy of the titles "Always brave" and "The first in the danger of freedom". Scenario of one of the bloodiest episodes of the Spanish Civil War and protagonist of the explosion of the tourist boom of the 1960s and 1970s, is now a remarkable center of entertainment, economic, cultural and communications node on the Mediterranean coast and the true epicenter of the famous coastal area called Costa del Sol.

Marseille, located in the southeast of France, is the second most important city in France after Paris, whose port is the most important in France and one of the most important in Europe. Marseille is an important junction between France, Spain, Italy and Switzerland. Marseille was founded by Focese sailors around 600 B.C. It was incorporated into the French crown in 1481 and benefited from its strategic alliance with the Ottoman Empire during the Renaissance and the Ancien Régime. The French Revolution baptized with the name of La Marseillaise, the military march that later became the national anthem and one of the greatest symbols of France.

Tours in Savona - Sailing the Mediterranean Sea

Savona is an Italian city located in the north-west of the country.

Ancient settlement of the Ligurian Sabacians, the city was an ally of Carthage in the Second Punic War against the Roman Empire. Former settlement of the Ligurian Sabacians, the city was an ally of Carthage in the second Punic war against the Roman Empire that finally subdued Savona around 180 B.C. and gave it the name of Savo Oppidum Alpinum. Centuries later, during the rule of Charlemagne's Franks, Savona experienced a period of great economic and commercial expansion. However, its period of maximum splendor took place in the 15th century, giving it the name of "City of the Popes". This is because one of the most influential families of the city, the Della Rovere, had among its members two of the successors of St. Peter: Francesco della Rovere (Sixtus IV), and his nephew Giuliano Della Rovere (Julius II). The first, promoter of the Sistine Chapel; the second, patron of Michelangelo, Bramante and Raphael.
